I want to keep you informed about new services and resources at the library:

## **Library hours' extension:**

Using the same resources, starting from the beginning of spring 2005 semester the Architecture Library will operate additional 4 hours during the weekends:

- • 12 noon - 6pm on Saturday
- • 1 pm - 7pm on Sunday

## **Extended borrowing privileges:**

At the Faculty Library Committee meeting of Dec 17, 2004, a proposal was adopted to extend borrowing privileges for graduate students university-wide via a 3<sup>rd</sup> renewal (e.g., 28 day initial loan, plus 3 renewals of 28 days each for a total of 112 days). It is being implemented for the spring 2005 semester.

Library was awarded **additional funds for acquisition** of books, journals and databases during the FY 2004-2005. We will keep you informed regarding our progress in this area.

I also want to bring to your attention some **new materials on the Web:**

**RedLightGreen** - a freely available Web site, which searches millions of records from the RLG Union Catalog. It helps you to locate books in libraries across the country and to create a bibliography by downloading citations in various styles (Chicago, APA, MLA, etc.) Try it at <http://www.redlightgreen.com>

**Keyhole** - delivers a 3D digital model of the entire earth via the Internet.
